



**THE LIES OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CHINA

# Introduction

---

The beginning of January 2020 brought with it information about a new type of virus in China, and for some, the immediate concern was what kind of impact this would have on the Chinese economy. Not many, at that time, could imagine it would transform into a global pandemic which would bring economic cycles to a halt in many countries, or isolate people in their homes due to forced quarantine. Some measures, like the ban on going out and limiting production amount in factories, have not happened on such a scale since the Second World War.

A majority of the world thought at that time that the virus had revealed itself in China at the start of 2020, and therefore there was plenty of time left. Only a few noticed that the pandemic had actually begun its spread in November 2019, and had managed to infect hundreds of thousands of people in the meantime, people that would travel all over the world, spreading it further. It was in this manner that the pandemic came out of China before China itself had even spoke about it, and during that time China was lying to the world. It was hiding all the relevant evidence and deceiving the world through the World Health Organization (WHO). It once again displayed its evil nature, only concerned its own gain and public relations.

Sadly, it really did happen like that, and the pandemic of the CCP virus (virus of the Chinese communist party, because it let it spread freely) spread into the whole world. The pandemic has infected over 3 million people and killed over two hundred thousand. And this number contains only the official data from China which, based on the research, is 42 times lower than the reality. The latest estimates concerning the situation state that China has more than 3 million infected and that around 42 thousand people died just in the place of the origin of the virus, Wuhan. That vastly differs from the official numbers of 83 infected and 4.5 thousand deaths in the whole of China, a country with 1.5 billion citizens.

It should be noted that by comparison, Italy, with 60 million citizens, has over 195 thousand cases of infection and 26 thousand deaths. The truth is, nobody actually believes the numbers from China. If we use an independent estimate, then just China alone should have 3.5 million [cases](#) of infected patients and 150

thousand deaths. That would amount to 6 million infected worldwide and over 350 thousand victims, which actually sounds like a realistic number. Yet it will take time to get the real numbers, and not only for China, as the pandemic is still going on, and not that many people have been tested for the virus.

That's all concerning the consequences of the pandemic. Another aspect of it is the material damage it has caused. The first estimates for China tell us about a drop in GDP of up to 4% which amounts to around 568 billion USD. But this does not take into account the real damages the businessmen in China have incurred, or the damages the households have incurred. Usually these numbers could be obtained from statistics, but China does not report the true numbers, but the numbers that the Chinese communist party wants to report. As a result, we may never come to know them. Certain first estimates for the U.S. report a decrease in GDP of up to 6%, which would amount to a loss of 1.3 trillion USD.

Could the loss of lives and material damages have been prevented? That is a question we ourselves have asked at our institute, since we have been researching the long-term crimes of communism and China is at present the biggest existing communist regime in the world. On top of that, this crime is similar to other crimes of the 21st century, or decades of the last century that it has committed. If China were not concealing evidence and information, how much would lower would the losses be? And if the CCP were indeed covering up the real situation, should it be held responsible? And if so, should it take part in compensating for the damages it has caused?

China tried to [cure](#) a coronavirus-infected patient with a lung transplant. Yet the doctor was not sure if the lungs were not infected.



# A British Report States That China Violated the Legally Binding International Health Regulations

---

A British report from Henry Jackson Society, looking into the possibilities of compensation that individuals, companies and countries can request from China due to the coronavirus pandemic, arrived at the conclusion that China violated articles 6 and 7 of the International Health Regulations, which are legally binding for China.

The report, among other things, quantifies the damages, which would amount to over 3.2 trillion pounds just for the G7 countries. It also looks into the possible legal steps and considers the regulations and courts which could be used for requesting the compensation of damages. These are not only the International



Health Regulations adopted in 2003 after the SARS pandemic, but also the International Court of Justice, arbitral tribunals, courts in Hong Kong, certain possibilities in the World Trade Organization, and others.

The report as a whole accuses China mainly of hiding evidence about the fact that the virus can spread from human-to-human for a period of 3 weeks from the time it had become aware of it. Then of providing the World Health Organization with false information during the first half of January, or that it allowed 5 million citizens of Wuhan to leave the city before 23rd January, when it was finally closed – all the while knowing about the dangers of the coronavirus.

## Petitions & Lawsuits

---

Some countries and other bodies announced plans of investigating the origin of the virus, or stated their unhappiness with how China handled the situation, while others already committed to certain actions. One of the first [petitions](#) to gather a lot of signatures (over 100,000) was addressed to the White House, which requested the U.S. president to hold China accountable for the coronavirus pandemic. Other petitions are then focused mainly on the compensation for damages, while another petition related to the coronavirus from the general point of view is being organized by the U.S. media Epoch Times, which asks for the [condemnation](#) of the Chinese communist party due to how it has handled the pandemic.

There are also several lawsuits against China related to compensation for damages. One such [lawsuit](#) was filed by U.S. lawyer Larry Klayman, along with Freedom Watch, seeking compensation of 20 trillion USD.

One of the states in the U.S., Missouri, has also [filed](#) a lawsuit against China for silencing its doctors, deceiving the world and other things. Any successful lawsuits would be very costly, as any estimations of the compensation amount easily to tens of billions of USD. Even the German newspapers, Bild, [estimated](#) it to be over 160 billion USD. Another was filed by a group of lawyers from Florida, “Berman Law Group”, who already have [experience](#) with a similar situation, as China paid them around 1.2 billion USD in the past account of defective building materials. Meanwhile, the individual countries focus mainly on investigating the origin of the virus and demand greater transparency from China. This perspective was expressed by the German chancellor Angela Merkel, the U.S. president Donald Trump, or Australian minister of foreign affairs, Marise Payne.

# Timeline

## 30<sup>th</sup> December

Chinese doctors warned about a virus which could spread from human to human, only to be silenced. One of them, Li Wenliang, also dies because of the virus.

## 14<sup>th</sup> January

The WHO shares information from China on Twitter that the virus can spread from human to human.

Meanwhile, Taiwan sends its own doctors to Wuhan that indeed confirm the existence of the virus and that it spread from human to human.

Also, the leadership of the Chinese communist party hosts a conference about the coronavirus, and already knows how it spreads, and that it will affect all countries in the world.

## 11<sup>th</sup> March

The WHO declares the coronavirus outbreak a global pandemic.

## 8<sup>th</sup> December

The official date of the first known case of coronavirus infection, as is mentioned in the WHO report.

## 31<sup>st</sup> December

Taiwan unsuccessfully asks the WHO about unusual cases of pneumonia. It also arrives at the conclusion that it could be a virus, spreadable between humans.

China reports a new type of flu in Wuhan to the WHO.

## 23<sup>rd</sup> January

Wuhan starts closing down but the citizens of China had traveled to all other countries by that time, and as a result, the virus had spread to other countries.


# World Health Organization and its source of information

Taiwan asked the WHO on 31st December for any relevant information regarding seven infected patients in Wuhan in China.

While receiving no reply, it arrived at the conclusion that the virus can spread human-to-human, and in the middle of January, it sent its own experts to Wuhan, who confirmed the conclusion.



The WHO knew about the first case of infection by coronavirus on 8<sup>th</sup> December, as is seen in its report.



Yet on 14<sup>th</sup> January, the WHO shared on Twitter: “Preliminary investigations conducted by the Chinese authorities have found no clear evidence of human-to-human transmission of the novel #coronavirus” It seems that Taiwan was verifying information coming from China, but the WHO was not.

# International Criminal Tribunal

---

The infection of the CCP virus, which has been causing a significant number of deaths and dramatic material damages all over the world, could have been slowed down based on the information mentioned earlier. The consequences could have been less severe, whether referring to the impact on the world economy or the victims. The ultimate answer, then, to the question about whether we could have prevented such a loss of lives and damages is: yes. China could have reacted six weeks earlier, were it not for its lies to the world and concealing of evidence. Based on the available data, the impact could have been 95% less, if China had reacted immediately, instead of censoring the information. How much would that have lessened the impact on the rest of the world? The Chinese communist party, as the leading party in China, is therefore responsible for this, and should take part in alleviating the cost of the damages caused, as these could have otherwise been prevented. Of course, while the speed of the infection should have been surprising, at least the epicenter of the infection could have been put into quarantine three weeks earlier (before closing down Wuhan), it could have limited the travel to the rest of the world, and there is no doubt that it should have informed the rest of the world about the new virus, so it could start its own preparations.

Let us ask a hypothetical question – what would happen, were the U.S., for example, to have known about the new pandemic and its infection rate already during the first week of the New Year and therefore the preventive measures would already have been implemented in February, instead of March? How much would that have reduced the damages? Research shows that it would be at least by 65%. If we go by the figure mentioned in the introduction, that would translate to 845 billion USD. And that's just the economical side of it. What then would the cost of human life have been? 65% less victims can't be translated into money. Just during the last week of April, the pandemic has cost 50 thousand lives in the U.S. Such a loss can't be expressed by just a number. On the other hand, for China, 50 thousand victims is nothing so important, as based on estimates, it kills around 60 thousand prisoners of conscience annually, whose only crime is a different belief, different political view, or ethnicity, if not for the reason of transplant tourism and illegal organ harvesting. Yet for the

western world, which cherishes human lives, such a figure is significant. Should the CCP be put on trial for these damages and losses? Yes, it should. The whole communist party with all its representatives, as the normal citizens in China have lost the most. Yet before which kind of a court can it be put, if China financially supports a lot of international institutions, such as the World Health Organization?

For example this organization has a director who is influenced by Chinese money in Africa. The United Nations as a whole is significantly influenced by China, since even such an absurd [situation](#) as a Chinese member of the CCP being put onto the council of human rights at the UN could have transpired. A representative of a country which despises human rights on the largest scale in the world. Because of these situations, the solution is to create a new type of court, an International Criminal Tribunal, which would consist of the representatives of the countries which were hit by the pandemic the most, such as Spain, Italy, the U.S., France, United Kingdom, Germany, Iran, and others that suffered. This is the right moment when the CCP should be put on trial for all the crimes it has committed in its bloody past, similarly to how the world put the evil of fascism on trial after the end of the Second World War. The leadership of then-fascist Germany was held accountable for all the crimes committed during the Nuremberg trials, where the parties judging them were the U.S., the United Kingdom and the Soviet Union. The main representatives of the Nazis were judged before a martial criminal court in Nuremberg.

The international society took a firm stance against the atrocities that had been committed during those times. And, well, the then-fascist Germany caused a holocaust and genocide, yet the Communist party of China represents a more brutal regime which caused more deaths than the Second World War altogether, over 80 million. In many aspects, it resembles a genocide. But those being persecuted are actually Chinese citizens, even during the 21st century. If we were to just single out the cases of Falun Gong practitioners, or Uyghurs in Xinjiang, these two acts already constitute a genocide. Yet the Chinese communist party is still among us and still destroying human lives in the 21st century.

That is why we call upon all the people in the world, to let the Chinese communist party be judged before the International Criminal Tribunal, and let it be held responsible not only for the crime of the massive loss of lives and significant financial losses as a consequence of hiding the truth about the new type of virus and letting it spread freely, but also for:

The crime of genocide on its own citizens from its creation to the present,  
Illegal practices of organ harvesting from prisoners of conscience, religious groups and national minorities,  
suppressing freedom in Hong Kong, going against the international regulations it agreed upon,  
the assimilation, imprisonment and suppression of Uyghurs in Xinjiang since at least 2014,  
persecuting and oppressing the representatives of the underground Christian society since 2009,  
the persecution, torture and killing of Falun Gong practitioners since 1999,  
the massacre on Tiananmen square in 1989,  
The death of tens of millions of people during the great famine in 1958, which occurred due to the party's policies for the production of steel at the cost of agriculture and due to not supplying citizens with the stored food,  
the death of hundreds of thousands due to the anti-rightist movement in 1957, as they were led to believe they could freely express their opinion, but were executed instead,  
the forced occupation of Tibet, which has resulted in hundreds of thousands of dead Tibetans as a result of imprisonment, forced labor, and also in assimilation of the population,

And for many other crimes, such as land reform, destroying religious groups, the persecution of landowners, and others, in the 1950s, which resulted in the deaths of millions of Chinese citizens and, due to the influence of the communist ideology, also the deaths of millions in other parts of the world.

This latest crime, the spread of the virus, concerns all of us. Like this, the Chinese communist party shifted its crimes to the whole world. It is at this moment that the world should react and let the leading representatives of the CCP be put on trial, for the bil-

lions in material damages and hundreds of thousands of human lives lost. We have personal losses in our families, and our freedom of movement is limited, as well as our activities. The economic situation, losses of jobs and businesses has negatively affected our lives. A lot of aspects of our lives have changed, and the one responsible for it is the CCP, as it concealed important information from the world.

We should not be deceived by the present economic prosperity and a face, which is seemingly more kind, since the nature of the party has remained the same, and it is still the serial killer of the past. It has been persecuting its own citizens up until the present, imprisons them in re-education camps without legal evidence, where it tortures them and even executes them for their organs. The present state of denial of the pandemic, which impacts all of us, is evidence of this. The deception also lies in the medical mask diplomacy, which is used as a means to gain more political influence, authority, profit, and especially diverting attention elsewhere – from the role of the Chinese communist party in this crisis.

Based on the gravity of the situation and the scale of the crimes the CCP has committed and for which it was never judged, and never distanced itself from, we recommend that the international society create an International Criminal Tribunal, which would consist of the representatives of countries which have suffered, and which would hold the leading representatives of the Chinese communist party accountable. The existence of this very party should be forbidden, as the Chinese citizens have suffered under its rule the most, yet still can't vote for their own leadership, as the authoritarian regime forbids them from doing so. The communist ideology, based on class struggle and violence, should be forbidden, with its symbols outlawed, similarly to the fascist ideology.
